## Other Instructions:

- 1. The Re-exam will be conducted through the Webex app as per the date sheet at 9:00AM.
- 2. Students will be required to appear in only those subjects in which they did not secure 33%.
- 3. The Exam will be of 2 hours and maximum marks will be 50
- 4. The concerned subject teacher will be invigilating their respective students.
- 5. Once the exam is over the student is supposed to scan/click the picture of the answer sheets in front of the camera and send to the invigilator immediately. This whole process should be completed in the supervision of the invigilator before leaving the session.
- 6. A mock exam will be conducted on 30<sup>th</sup> May 2020 to enable the students and parents to understand this process.
- 7. Students should prepare according to the revised syllabus given in the date sheet.
- 8. The student will have to score 33% in these exams to be declared pass.
- 9. The result of the re exams will be final and no more chances will be granted thereafter.
- 10. It will be the responsibility of the parent to provide required hardware/device and good internet connection for smooth conduction of the exam.
